R.E.: Criminal Investigation Up-date:

As per our conversation this date, this letter is to confirm that the investigation is ongoing. The investigation is progressing in an efficient manner, which may appear to be a slow pace. This pace is due to the large volume of BMA documents, which had to be reviewed, and the amount of attention to detail required. The ongoing interviews and the collection of documents are necessary to confirm many details in the documents relating to the delivery of many of the programs involving the MBA. Numerous interviews need to be conducted and documentation yet to be acquired, before any charges can be laid.

Due to the size and complexity of the investigation that spans from 1992 to 2003, there is a requirement to scan electronically and code all of the 20,000 plus documents for analysis and court proceedings once charges are laid. Unfortunately this is a very time consuming process, which is slowed down by the manpower limitations created by other more urgent investigations at the detachment.

I cannot provide you with any further details about the investigations results until charges are laid at which time I will notify the Board of Directors of the names of those charged and the resulting charges.
